

NOTICE OF STRIKE

Sisters and Brothers,

As you know last night, we granted the Company's request for a 24 hour strike deadline extension. We did this in GOOD FAITH because it appeared that the Company was going to start taking us seriously at the table.

After working until 2:30 am last night, we were expecting some big moves from the Company this morning. Unfortunately, the Company came back to the table with absolutely nothing. Instead, they offered that we engage in joint mediation through the Labour Board.

Although, mediation can, at times, be useful, we view the Company's lack of action this morning as a stall tactic and a slap in the membership's face.

We came here to bargain, not play games.

We remain willing to bargain, unfortunately, the Company has left us with no choice but to withdraw our services tonight (July 25 at 12:01 am).

Other than members that are ordered to work in accordance with the Essential Services Order, we ask that you safely leave the plant at that time, in a nonconfrontational manner and head to one of the picket lines as we will be on STRIKE. The North Cafeteria picket line has an unlimited capacity. However, the glass house picket line is limited to a maximum of 20 people and 10 vehicles.
