

NOTICE OF MOTIONS TO POST

In accordance with Article 9 (1)(c) of our Local Bylaws,

“Executive Board Expenditures:

Expenditures approved by a membership meeting shall not exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) unless notice of motion has been posted in the Union Office and on the plant bulletin boards at least two (2) weeks in advance.”

There will be special membership meetings on Monday, November 15, 2021, at 7:00 PM and Tuesday, November 16, 2021 at 7:00 AM to consider the following motions regarding Strike Fund Support and additional dues deductions:

Motion #1

Whereas: The Unifor Local 2301 strike ended on October 1, 2021, when the new agreement was ratified.

Whereas: Members will return to work over a defined duration and in accordance with the Return to Work Protocol.

Whereas: It is the intention of the Local to provide members that are not working, not earning other income or not eligible for a government sponsored program with a weekly assistance amount up to \$400.00 per week.

Whereas: It is understood that if a member is working or is receiving other income that is less than \$400.00 per week, they will receive a top up assistance out of the strike fund to bring them to \$400.00 per week.

Whereas: It is understood that the total allowance money that is provided to members, initially will be funded solely by the strike fund until the additional dues deductions have been processed by the Company.

Whereas: Members who receive money from work or other income that exceeds \$400.00 per week and at the same time receive assistance money from the Local, will be responsible to reimburse the Local in full.

Whereas: The Executive will review the numbers on an ongoing basis and have the power to reduce the hours of additional dues deducted per pay period as needed.

Therefore: The Executive recommends to the membership that we deduct an additional two hours dues per pay period to provide assistance to Local 2301 members who have not been returned to work. The assistance will combine the dues deducted with money from the strike fund, not to exceed \$400.00 per week, for members that are not working, receiving other income or become eligible to receive funds from a government sponsored program. The duration of the assistance will continue until such time as the last regular fulltime member has had an opportunity to return to work or seven months from ratification, whichever is sooner.

Motion #2

The Executive recommends to the membership that once the assistance money for members not returned to work has terminated, the additional dues per pay period will be redirected to replenish the strike fund.
